

PAM BROCK TEACHER/ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP

Pam was a lifetime resident of this valley and attended all of her primary and secondary grades right here in Parachute/Grand Valley. Her two children also graduated from Grand Valley High School. She served as the secretary to the superintendent in the Grand Valley school system for several years and was passionate about the education of all. For this reason, her family felt that this scholarship would be appropriate to be given in her memory. The family would prefer to give the money to a student who is planning on going into teaching as their post-secondary focus. However, all students who are planning on going on to a 2 or 4 year college are invited to apply.

Pam touched the hearts of everyone she knew. Her ready smile was welcomed by everyone in the community. After retiring from her many jobs in education and elsewhere, she took a job in 1998 as a rural mail carrier that she really enjoyed. She was able to be in the middle of nature daily in the country that she so loved. After her death in 2002, her family asked for donations to be made in her honor for a scholarship fund. Over the years, the family has held a silent auction at the annual reunion with all funds going to this fund. Her very generous family has been able to keep this scholarship going strong.

The Pam Brock Teacher/Academic Scholarship, in the amount of \$2,000.00, is to be awarded each spring to a Grand Valley High School senior who is enrolling full time (at least 12 credit hours) at an accredited two year or four year college. The scholarship committee will give preference to those who are enrolling in a teaching training program, but the scholarship is open to all to apply. This is a two year scholarship with \$1,000.00 being applied to the recipient's first year tuition and \$1,000.00 being applied to the tuition for the second year, if the student remains in a teacher education program.

METHOD OF PAYMENT:

The scholarship award will be deposited in the Financial Aid Office of the college that the recipient will be attending and will be made payable to that institution. \$500 will be deposited prior to the start of the academic year, in August, for payment of fall semester expenses. The second payment of \$500 will be deposited in January for payment of spring semester expenses after proof of completion of at least 12 credit hours with a minimum grade point average of 2.50gpa is received by GVEF. The scholarship installments for the second year will be handled in the same manner as described above.

SELECTION PROCESS:

The successful applicant will be selected by the Scholarship Committee of the Grand Valley Educational Foundation.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

Acceptance Letter to an accredited two year or four year college.

Class standing- Grade point average along with ACT or SAT scores.

Leadership activities, community service and participation in extra-curricular activities both in and out of school.

Evaluation of what applicants write about themselves. Evaluation of two letters of recommendation.
