

BENSON FAMILY TEACHER SCHOLARSHIP

The Benson Family is a long-time family in the Parachute area. Many family members were raised on a ranch up Parachute Creek about 8 miles. Ruth Benson, the family matriarch was a teacher for many years at the one room Granlee Schoolhouse “up the creek”. Education is very important to all members of the Benson family, many of whom still live in the area. There have been 6 generations of this family in the area with 3 of those generations graduating from Grand Valley High School.

The family gets together each summer for a reunion where an auction is held to raise money for the ongoing funding of these scholarships. As members of the family are lost, it is asked that donations be made to this scholarship fund. It has grown over the years and the family is happy to be able to contribute to the higher learning of graduating students from Grand Valley High School.

The \$2,000.00, two year Benson Family Teacher Scholarship honors the memory of Pam Brock, Roberta “Bobbi” Wambolt, and Charline Allen, three of the seven Benson children raised “up the creek.”

BENSON FAMILY TEACHER SCHOLARSHIP
(Administered by the Grand Valley Educational Foundation)

The Benson Family Teacher Scholarship, in the amount of \$2,000.00, is to be awarded each spring to a Grand Valley High School senior who is enrolling full time (at least 12 credit hours) in an accredited two or four-year college. This is a two-year scholarship with \$1,000.00 being applied to the recipient's first yeartuition and \$1,000.00 being applied to the tuition for the second year, if the student remains in good standing while continuing their education.

METHOD OF PAYMENT:

The scholarship award will be deposited in the Financial Aid Office of the college that the recipient will be attending and will be made payable to that institution. \$500 will be deposited prior to the start of the academic year, in August, for payment of fall semester expenses. The second payment of \$500 will be deposited in January for payment of spring semester expenses after proof of completion of at least 12 credit hours with a minimum grade point average of 2.50 GPA. The scholarship award for the secondyear will be handled in the same manner.

SELECTION PROCESS:

The successful applicant will be selected by the Scholarship Committee of the Grand Valley Educational Foundation.

CRITERIA FOR SELECTION:

- Acceptance into an accredited two-year or four-year college.
- Class standing- Grade point average
- ACT or SAT scores.
- Leadership activities
- Community service
- Participation in extra-curricular activities both in and out of school.
- Evaluation of what applicants write about themselves.
- Evaluation of at least two letters of recommendation.
